OR

- Higher / Advanced Diploma with two years of work experience.

OR

- Diploma with 5 years of works experience.

OR

- Any recognized professional qualification that is acceptable to the Kotelawala Defence University and a minimum of two years of work experience in a managerial post.

OR

- 5 years work experience (with 2 years Executive level experience) and currently holding a Managerial capacity appointment.

The selection of candidates will be made on an aptitude test and the basis of the performance at an interview. FGS has rights to conduct an Aptitude test before candidates are called for the interview and have a good working knowledge of English.

Medium and methods of instruction

English will be the medium of instructions. The teaching methods will be classroom level and m-learning online with the application of hybrid mode of review workshops seminars. 50% attendance is required for each subject
