

## **Terms, Conditions & Procedure for students applying with Pending G.C.E A/L Results-2020**

It is proposed to enroll Day Scholars for Intake 38 (2<sup>nd</sup> Batch) subject to following Terms and Conditions.

1. The candidates who sat for G.C.E (A/L) Examination in 2020 (Pending Results) are eligible to send their E-Applications for the degree programmes mentioned in the Advertisement. A candidate can apply for more than one degree programme using the same application by paying LKR 1000 for each as application fee.
2. Basic Requirement  
The Candidate should,
  - a. Be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
  - b. Have obtained minimum of a credit pass (C) for English Language at the G.C.E O/L Examination or minimum of a 'D' Grade for English Language at the London O/L Examination.
  - c. Fulfill following age limit by the closing date of application.
    - i. 17-30 years – LLB Degree Programme
    - ii. 18-24 years – BSc (Hons) Aircraft Maintenance
    - iii. 18-28 years – BSc (Hons) Aircraft Maintenance ( Top-up degree programme)
    - iv. 17-24 years – Degree Programmes other than LLB, Aircraft Maintenance
3. Based on the applications received, candidates will be given access to attend the online lectures from home for the respective degree programme they applied for. If the student has applied for more than one degree programme, priority will be given to his/her first preference when allowing them to attend online lectures.
4. Once the G.C.E A/L 2020 Examination results are published by the Department of Examinations, the candidate is required to re-submit his/her original results to the university within 5 working days in order to consider the eligibility as per the basic requirements for each degree programmes which is published in the advertisement. Thereafter a cutoff point of Z-Score will be decided by KDU considering the number of applications & size of the batch, etc. for each Degree Programme.
5. An aptitude test and a structured interview will be conducted to select suitable candidates as Day Scholars for Degree Programmes. The selected candidates will be enrolled to the University subject to the Documents Verification and signing agreements.
6. Candidates are required to pay LKR of 10,000 as “Provisional Registration Fee” together with their application fee since they are allowed to attend the online lectures for the applied degree programme for the period from the date of commencement of academic activities till the date of enrollment with pending G.C.E A/L 2020 examination results.
7. After shortlisting applications based on original results and succeeded in the Selection test & Structured Interview, if the candidate is selected to follow the degree programme, the paid amount of LKR 10,000 will be deducted from the course fee of the degree programme. Under any circumstances, if the candidate is failed to get selected, the “Provisional Registration Fee” of LKR 10,000 shall not be refunded.

8. If the student has applied for more than one degree programme and failed to get selected for his/her first preference, he/she will be considered for other degree programmes in the preference list. In such case, the student shall be responsible to cover any missed lectures by referring lecture materials made available in Learning Management System (LMS) of KDU.
9. Those students who failed to get selected for any of the degree programme applied will be given a certificate for attending lectures from the date of commencement of academic activities and to the date of enrollment of selected candidates.
